To the Board of Directors of Lucent Industries Ltd (Formerly known as Sylph Education Solutions Limited)

1. We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of unaudited standalone financial results of **Lucent Industries Ltd (Formerly known as Sylph Education Solutions Limited)** for the quarter ended 30 June 2023 ("the Statement"), being submitted pursuant to the requirements of Regulation 33 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ('Listing Regulations').
